**Important information about the Vodafone pay as you talk service**

I am writing to explain a few changes that will soon be happening to our call charges. Some call costs are being reduced by a few pence and other costs are being increased.

**How will these changes affect you?**

From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2003, calls to other mobile phone networks will cost 35p per minute at any time of day or night when using the pay as you talk allcalls price plan. (These calls are currently 50p per minute during weekday daytime and 30p per minute at any other time). In addition, the minimum charge for a call will be adjusted to 10p. There is no change to the standard cost for calling national and local UK numbers, other Vodafone mobiles or for sending text messages.
